RE: CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 INFORMATION

Dear Valued Customer,

The California Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, commonly referred to as California Proposition 65 (CA Prop 65) requires manufacturers to provide customers with notification about chemicals in the products they purchase. Staub Metals, while not a manufacturer, supplies steel products and complies to this requirement by providing the following in regards to its steel products.

Steel sold by Staub Metals, Inc. contains chemicals listed in the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Prop 65). These steel products present no health hazard during transportation, storage and some processing methods.

However, fabrication methods such as grinding, welding or flame cutting, could generate fine particulates, gaseous materials and fumes which could expose the user to nickel, which is known to the state of California to cause cancer, or hexavalent chromium which is known to the state of California to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
